

Start here asking for God to cleanse your heart:

Almighty God, to you all hearts are open, all desires known, and from you no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you, and worthily magnify your holy Name; through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Take the following verse to heart!

Jeremiah 29:7 “seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the LORD on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare”

- **Step 1: As you walk, ask God to bless the city where you are walking! Invite the Lord into your walk and ask him to guide your prayer time either silently or out loud.**

Lord, we invite you into this city where we walk. We ask you to bless this city in any area where brokenness, injustice, hardship, homelessness, hopelessness, and broken families are present. We ask that we can be a conduit of your blessing in this city, but we acknowledge that without your help, we cannot do it. Guide us Lord and bless this city so that your name may be known on earth! Amen.

- **Step 2: Ask the Lord to give you His eyes to see anything that needs his presence and care. Take time to notice the houses, the people and any place that needs the Lord.**

Lord, we invite you to show us anything that needs your presence and care. We have been blessed in so many ways by you, that we desire to extend that blessing to others. Please help us to have your eyes of compassion and care. Help us not to overlook the outcast or the vulnerable. Give us a vision of your peace and shalom so that we can be your hands and feet in the coming months! Amen.

- **Step 3: As you walk, ask the Lord to give you the ears to hear anything he wants you to hear. Pause and take some time to hear the cars, the voices, the children or any other thing that he might want you to hear.**

Lord, you hear the cries of your people. You have ears that hear and eyes that see. We are blind to the injustice and deaf to the needs around us. Please remove our blind eyes and deaf ears to see what is truly important. Help us to hear your voice as we walk. Speak for your servants are listening. Amen
